Typical issues include--

- Schools with special scheduling needs
- Scheduling problems-- summer, on weekends
- How to get new school data for old applications
- USA's big backlog of school applications-- many have been in the queue over 1.5 years



Special topics included:

- A decision that the ARISS Europe Region should handle Brazilian applications
- A confirming of the requirement that applications should be submitted in English
- US and Australian telebridges will assist Russia



Report shared: NASA fiscal year '03 school evaluations--

- 41 of the 43 schools submitted evaluation forms
- 13,586 youths involved in the 41 school QSOs
- Another 650 students listened from other schools or facilities
- 890 teachers participated
