Hardware Selection

Hardware Selection

- Hardware Selection committee was proposed at the ESA/ESTEC meeting in the Netherlands, March 27/28 2000
- The Selection Committee mandate is to review *all proposals* for Amateur Radio on ISS and to make appropriate recommendations for suitability and order of launch.

Hardware Selection

- The committee was formally approved at the Goddard Space Center meeting later in 2000.
- One Member from Each region is on the committee, Japan, USA, Europe, Russia and Canada.
- Equipment should not be considered for purchasing, building or manifesting until the committee has reviewed the proposal and made an appropriate recommendation.
